SLSNSW is calling for nominations from athletes wishing to be considered for selection in the 2022 NSW Pool Rescue Interstate Team. The NSW Pool Rescue Team will compete in the Interstate Championships to be held at the Gold Coast Aquatic Centre, Southport, QLD on Friday 5 August 2022.

The team of 24 will be selected by the SLSNSW Selection Panel based on the following structure:

U15	2 x Male and 2 x Female
U17	2 x Male and 2 x Female
U19	2 x Male and 2 x Female
Open	2 x Male and 2 x Female

How to Nominate

- All nominating members are asked to familiarise themselves with the SLSNSW Selection Policy and the SLSNSW Athlete & Management Agreement. Athletes that are successful in gaining selection will be required to comply with the guidelines and expectations set out in these documents.

- All nominees must be current financial members and hold any relevant awards. All nominations must be endorsed by both Club and Branch representatives prior to selection, please contact your Club and Branch to acquire letters of endorsement. Any nomination that fails to meet these requirements will not be accepted.

Team Levy

All costs (including travel and accommodation) for the Interstate Championships in Queensland are the responsibility of individuals.

Uniform

Selected team members will be supplied a team uniform. Due to the tight turnaround between selection and competition, athletes may not receive specific sizes requested.

Training Sessions

Following selection, a training session may be conducted prior to the Interstate Championships. This sessions would likely be held on Sunday 31 July – further details to be provided at a later date.

It is anticipated that successful applicants will be notified shortly after the 2022 SLSNSW Pool Rescue Championships.

SLSA Anti-Doping Policy

Surf Life Saving Australia supports the Australian Government, SportAus, the AOC, and the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority (ASADA) in their efforts to eradicate the use of drugs in sport. SLSA has published an Anti-doping Policy, which will be adhered to for this event.

Please be aware that random drug testing by ASADA could take place during the competition. It is highly recommended each State/Territory team member (including management and staff) complete the ASADA online e-learning program (Level 1) to ensure all personnel are aware of contemporary issues pertaining to anti-doping.
