Parking is available at the Woy Woy Peninsula Leisure Centre with additional parking around the surrounding streets and at James Browne Oval. Please take note of the signage as some car parks have time restrictions.

Please note, entry will be via the event entrance at the side of the building. Competitors, team managers and spectators do not have to pay an admission fee on arrival as this has been covered in the competitor event entry fee.

Team Managers Meeting

A compulsory Team Managers meeting will be held:

- o 1.20pm Friday 22 July
- o 8.00am Saturday 23 July
- o 8.00am Sunday 24 July

One representative per Club will be permitted to attend. The location of the team managers meeting will be communicated on the day.

In the event of further Team Managers meetings being called during competition, it is asked that only Team Managers attend these meetings to ensure correct communication of information.

Event Program

Please refer to the <u>Program of Events</u> for running order for the 2022 NSW Pool Rescue Championships.

Competition Area / Marshalling

Only athletes contesting upcoming events and officials will be permitted in and around the pool deck. In particular, the timekeepers area is off limits to competitors and spectators (See Appendix A). Please keep clear of the area shaded in red to allow for officials. To assist with seating space it is asked that competitors be mindful of the amount of bags being brought into the seating arena. Camping chairs must be kept well clear of the pool and shall not obstruct exits or impede officials on the pool deck.

Athletes and Team Managers are asked to remain in the grandstand area unless being marshalled for an event. Marshalling occurs outside in the marshalling shelter. Please proceed anti-clockwise from the grandstand, outside to the shelter. Athletes will be marshalled into rows of heats with chairs representing their allocated lanes. Each heat will be walked in by the Marshall to the blocks from outside.

Please ensure you enter the marshalling area with everything you need to compete.

Warm Up

Please note: ATHLETES MUST STAY AWAY FROM THE ELECTRONIC TOUCH PADS DURING WARM UP. Please note that there are limited warm up opportunities – please be courteous and share the lanes.

Volunteer Quota (Pool Setters & Time Keepers)

While Officials have been appointed to coordinate the event, a shift ratio (pool setters and timekeepers) has been developed based on the number of participants per club from the number of entries. This is required to ensure the efficient running of this Championship event and SLSNSW appreciates your involvement.

Please note these volunteers will not receive event catering. Only appointed accredited officials will receive carnival breakfast, morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea.

Timekeepers Roster

Time Keepers should report to Chief Time Keeper, Elaine Unger and sign on at the finish end of the pool deck 15 minutes prior to competition commencement.

SLSNSW recommends clubs set up a roster for their timekeeping allocations. Time keepers will not be required to bring their own stop watches as these will be supplied by SLSNSW.

Event Administration

Heat Sheets/Lane Draws

The Heat Sheet will be uploaded on the <u>Pool Rescue Championships Event Page</u> on Wednesday evening. Please refer to the Heat Sheets generated from team entries.

SLSNSW does not expect significant changes, however if there is incorrect info please submit changes by **2pm Thursday 21 July** via email to Jess Mensforth, Senior Competitions Coordinator at jmensforth@surflifesaving.com.au
as this will reduce the administration burden at the event.

After **2pm Thursday**, Team Managers are asked to record any changes or scratching via the 'Team Changes Notification Advice' which is available to download from our <u>website</u> and via Team App.

Entry Changes

Should competitors wish to withdraw from a race, please advise the Referee Steward as soon as practical. Additional events are \$19.90 incl GST and there are no late entries. For example, a competitor already entered in an event but wanting to enter an event where they are not currently entered is an Additional Event. A team of 4 competitors = $$19.90 \times 4$. If the competitor is not entered in any events at the 2022 NSW Pool Rescue Championships they cannot be accepted as a late entry.

Entry Payment

SLSNSW will issue an invoice to the club based on the entries in Meet Manager after the conclusion of the event.

Presentation

The Presentation will occur at the western side of the pool deck (inside). Presentations will occur 'in blocks' after events have been run. Please listen to announcements.

Note: SLSNSW will not be posting out any unclaimed medals; it is the responsibility of Clubs to collect medals from presentation throughout the day. Do not wait until the end of the day to collect your medals.

Meet Manager Mobile

This event may be accessible via the Meet Manager Mobile app on IOS and Android. Team Management and supporters are encouraged to download the app prior to the Championships. This is reliant on the capability of the venue.

On Friday, once Meet Mobile has been activated, you will be able to find the meet by searching "2022 SLSNSW Pool Rescue Championships" within the app. PLEASE NOTE THAT DUE TO THE NUMBER OF CHANGES THAT ARE MADE TO EVENTS (DUE TO SCRATCHINGS ETC) MEET MANAGER MAY NOT BE UP TO DATE AND WILL BE OFFLINE ON OCCASIONS. SLSNSW makes no guarantees that results or reports this app will be up to date or correct and it is only provided for reference only.

Please follow the advice of officials and referees (via announcements) regarding all aspects of competition and do not rely solely on the app.



Photography & Media

SLSNSW will not be issuing any media/photography accreditation to Team members or Team Management.

No competitor, team manager, official or spokesperson for a club shall make media statements which could bring the 2022 NSW Pool Rescue Championship, its sponsors, or officials into controversy or disrepute. Such statements shall be deemed to be a breach of SLSA discipline and will be dealt with accordingly. Statements to the media about the Series will be made only by approved SLSNSW personnel.

Equipment

SLSNSW will only be supplying the below equipment:

- Pool tubes
- Pool line throw ropes
- Pool bricks
- Pool obstacles

Pointscore

As per the entry circular an interclub point score will be conducted based on the results of individual and team events for 1st through to 6th placing (or less if the actual number of competitors is less than 6) for the Championships.

All events will be of equal points and the club with the highest aggregate of points at the conclusion of the competition shall be declared the winners in each division (Youth, Open, Masters).

Please note there is no Overall Club Point score.
