Subject: Accessing the June 2022 SLSNSW uniform credit

Dear Branch & Club Presidents,

As you would be aware from an earlier advice in June from Steve Pearce SLSNSW CEO, the SLSNSW Board approved a \$3,000 uniform credit for each Branch and Club to be accessed through the SLSA uniform shop. The following steps detail how clubs can access the grant credit.

- The grant can only be utilised for clothing that can be worn on patrol. This includes items such as patrol shirts & shorts, hats, rash vests, wet weather/wind breakers, track suit pants, etc (ie anything that can be worn as official patrol uniform). The grant cannot be used for items such as PFD's, first aid equipment, rescue equipment, general leisure wear/commemorative merchandise etc.
- Clothing can only be purchased via the SLSA on-line uniform shop, ie SLSA hold the credit for each club.
- Each club should already have a shop administrator with access to the on-line shop for purchases of patrol equipment and clothing. The shop is located in the members area under membership and then members' store. Any issues with access as an officer for your Club, please email tvombruch@slsa.asn.au
- Clubs can make multiple purchases over the course of the next 12 months utilising the credit. SLSA will consider extending the credit beyond 12 months upon request.
- Clubs should place an order and in the 'notes' section of the order, identify they wish to utilise the SLSNSW Uniform Credit.
- SLSA will process the order and apply the credit as a discount. SLSA will invoice the club for the balance (ie. a nil balance outstanding if the order is less than the credit the club holds at that time). Clubs can make an order for an amount greater than their remaining credit, SLSA will invoice the club for the outstanding balance, as they would for normal purchases.

The SLSNSW Board is pleased to be able to assist Branches and Clubs in this way and in doing so, assist clubs to ensure their patrolling membership is fitted out in the latest SLS branded uniform, appropriate to the prevailing conditions at their club.
