## Supplementary Rules and Notes:

- **Sydney Branch Clubs must provide U8- U14 proficient water safety personnel with caps/rashies on a one to 7 competitor ratio. Clubs will be advised of numbers and other administrative details following the close of entries.**
- **Other Competing Clubs are also requested to assist.**
- **All competing Clubs must provide Officials on a one to 10 competitor ratio.**
- Competition shall be conducted as per the current edition SLSA Surf Sports Manual except where detailed in this section.
- **Ohana** 2km Ski Challenge will be a sprint to shore or a downwind paddle into Wanda dependent on prevailing conditions. Details to be advised at marshalling.
- Water courses shall be set as short as practicable to encourage participation but also to ensure safe and fair competition.
- All competitors must have their age group clearly marked on their upper left arm.
- U9 to U15 Competitors must remain in their own age group in individual and team events unless otherwise listed. See also rules relating to R&R participation.
- All events will be conducted in block (i.e., heats (where required) and finals immediately following).
- If practicable some age groups may be joined together in other individual events to assist competition conduct. When this occurs, competitors should nominate their age category and individual results will be recorded for each age group.
- The U15 Male and Female Cameron Relay teams may be 2, 3 or 4 person teams. If it is a three-person team, the team enters one member of the team to complete both the beach sprint legs of the event. If it is a two person team there is no separate runner.
- The "Competitor with a Disability" events shall be open to members from U8 years of age. Dependent on numbers of age Groups will be U12 and under and U13 to U18. Male and Female races may be conducted but not separate disability classifications. Clubs shall also be required to provide one to one (1:1) SLS qualified water safety for the Surf, Board and Wade Races.
- Upon application to the Sectional Referee competitors may make up composite teams from different clubs and may be awarded placings (but not prizes or placing points for their individual clubs).
- The Club point score shall be 6 points for 1<sup>st</sup> through to 1 point for 6<sup>th</sup> for all events conducted on the day. Dead heats will share the allotted placing points, viz. equal first both score 6 points and third scores 4 points and overall trophy prizes (i.e., there will be no countback to determine the overall club point score winner).
- Consistent with the SLSA Application for Membership form and declaration, Wanda SLSC may take photographs for promotional and historical purposes only. Participation is acknowledgment of acceptance of the consent to SLSA for this to occur.
- The Carnival Committee reserves the right to cancel events and without refund of entry fees if any advertised events for the Carnival are conducted.
- Wanda SLSC regrets that (inclusive events excluded), it is unable to conduct U8 and March Past events this year because of limited beach.

## Prizes and Trophies:

- Medals plus **Voodoo Dry Caps** awarded to placegetters in U9 – U13 individual events.
- Participation medals and prizes for all inclusive Competitor with a Disability participants.

## Entries:

- Entries close at Surf Life Saving Sydney at Midnight on Wednesday, 16 November 2022. Wanda SLSC will then issue invoices.
- Entry fees of \$25 per individual competitor shall apply for the Wanda SLSC events.
- R&R Team Entry of \$55.00 per Team with the following exceptions:
  - Should one or both competitors in the 2 Person R&R enter events in addition to the 2 Person R&R there is no individual competitor fee payable.
  - Should one or both competitors in the 5/6 Person R&R enter events other than R&R the additional individual competitor fee is \$14.00 per person.
- Competitor with a Disability Entry Fees are free of charge.
- Each Individual Competitor in events other than R&R are to have their Live Heats wristband activated (or obtain a wristband – at cost of \$2.00) at the Registration Tents located on the grass between Wanda SLSC Clubhouse and the Sutherland Shire Council Lifeguard Building from 6.30 am.
- R&R teams do not need live heat wrist bands to participate in R&R events.
- Team Managers may also collect their payment receipts from the registration tent.
- Late entries on the day (accepted only if agreed prior to the day) will attract an additional \$15.00 per entry fee.  
**Note: Wanda SLSC must receive all entry fees on or before the date of the Carnival for a Club to be eligible to compete.**

## Parking:
