Subject:	Restricted Entry Events – 2023 NSW Surf Life Saving Championships	

The 2023 NSW Surf Life Saving Championships, proudly supported by Your local club, will have some events with restricted entries. This enables efficient and effective timetabling of these events from heats to finals with regards to surf and weather conditions.

Restrictions for NSW Age Championships

For the NSW Age Championships, the Ironperson, Board Rescue and All Age Board Relay will continue to be restricted events for U11-U14.

Competitors must continue to qualify through Branch, with the number of entries allocated as per the table below:

Note:

- The All Age Board Relay is restricted to two (2) teams per metropolitan branch and one (1) team per country branch.
- Clubs shall refer to Branch as to how qualification will occur.
- Clubs shall complete entries as per normal to ensure that competitors have been entered
 into the carnival by the close of entries. These Restricted Entry events will not be visible in
 SEMS so Clubs will NOT need to enter competitors into these events.

SLSNSW will require a list of qualifying competitors (individual events) or qualifying clubs (All Age Board Relay) from each **Branch**, by **Monday 13 February 2023** for the NSW Age Championships, and only these qualifiers will start. NSW Open Championships Restrictions

For the NSW Open Championships, the Lifesaver Relay will continue to be a restricted event in 2023.

Note:

- The Lifesaver Relay is restricted to two (2) teams per metropolitan branch and one (1) team per country branch.
- Clubs shall refer to Branch as to how qualification will occur.
- Clubs shall complete entries as per normal to ensure that competitors have been entered
 into the carnival by the close of entries. These Restricted Entry events will not be visible in
 SEMS so Clubs will NOT need to enter competitors into these events.
- Excluding the Surf Boat sweep within each team there must be four female and four male competitors, and they must meet age group requirements as per the 37th Edition Surf Sports Manual (one U17 competitor and one U19 competitor).

SLSNSW will require a list of qualifying clubs from each <u>Branch</u>, by <u>Monday 20 February 2023</u> for the NSW Open Championships and only these qualifiers will start. The list of Qualifiers must be submitted via JotForm available here:
