The appointment of Officials will be made after the close of nominations and an appointment letter will be issued to successful officials no later than Friday 14 April 2023.

Appointments for all rounds will be posted together, rather than round by round.

## **IRB Official Quota**

To support the on-going delivery and development of IRB competition, a quota will be implemented in 2023 based on a Clubs individual entries per Round/Championship to grow the number of IRB technical officials.

Clubs without sufficient currently accredited officials are advised that members should be encouraged to complete the online Technical Officials course. The face-to-face assessments will be run during the Premiership.

Members who have completed the online course will count towards the quota for the Premiership, however, must be accredited to count for the State IRB Championships.
