50th Interstate Craft Carnival entries via SEMS closing soon!

The 2023 Craft Carnival November 25th - 26th proudly held at Coffs Harbour SLSC, 23 Surf Club Rd.

With over 500 competitors, 50 officials, and 1,000 spectators, the event is shaping up to showcase two days of competition at Park Beach in Coffs Harbour.

AGE 'DOUBLE DIPPING'

All competitors must compete only in their age group. Competitors U17+ can compete in open mixed relays alongside U19, Open & Masters.

FEES

Late fees will not be charged for team event substitutions if the substitute is already entered into the carnival.

MERCHANDISE

Official Event Merchandise: Delfina and Sharkskin are Official Merchant partners for the carnival. Merchandise can be purchased from the lawned area outside Coffs Harbour SLSC.

TEAM APP

Team App: Stack Team App will be used throughout the carnival as a platform to communicate important information and timetable changes to Officials, Team Managers, and Competitors.

To receive live event updates, participants can download the "Stack Team App" application and join the "Coffs Craft Carnival 2023" group.

LIVE HEATS

Live Heats: North Coast Branch will be implementing the Live Heats carnival management system for marshalling, recording results, and calculating the overall point score. Competitors must bring their Live Heats wristbands, which must be allocated prior to the start of competition. Additional wristbands can be requested from SLSNC at an additional cost.

TEAM MANAGERS

A compulsory Team Managers meeting will be held **Friday evening at 7pm** via zoom. It is important for Team Managers or dedicated club personnel to attend to receive vital event-specific information.

SAFETY

Pink Lycra vests are mandatory for all competitors to wear throughout the carnival.

ENVIRONMENT

Location Specific Details: The Craft Carnival will be hosted in Coffs Harbour with the support of Coffs Harbour City Council. The sand dunes at Park Beach are an important ecological feature, and access to the competition site should only be through designated pathways. Mesh fencing will be in place to deter individuals from accessing the dunes. Competitors and officials are encouraged to leave no evidence of human

impact and respect the off-limit areas.

TIDES

It is expected that the tide will be high in the morning both days and dropping throughout the later part of the day. We suspect rowing boats to the competition area may be required, launching from the creek.



SITE & MAPS

The competition area consists of 2 areas, a boat area (A second boat area may be required) and craft area. Access to the competition arena is restricted and requires escort by a competition official. Only one handler per competitor is permitted in the arena. The spectator area is located behind the competition arenas.



WARM UPS

The warm-up schedule includes a swim session from 7:00 am to 7:30 am and a craft session from 7:30 am to 7:50 am. Competitors must wear a pink high-visibility rash vest during warm-ups, and warm-ups should not commence before 7 am.

A Power craft Roster is in place for the safety of competitors.

STALLS

Several stallholders, including Delfina & Sharkskin, will be present.

BBQ

Coffs Harbour SLSC has a BBQ available at the clubhouse, which will be running on the throughout the carnival.

PRIZES

Voucher & Prize Collection - Voucher draws will take place on the beach after discipline finals are complete. - All vouchers and prizes must be collected at the carnival.

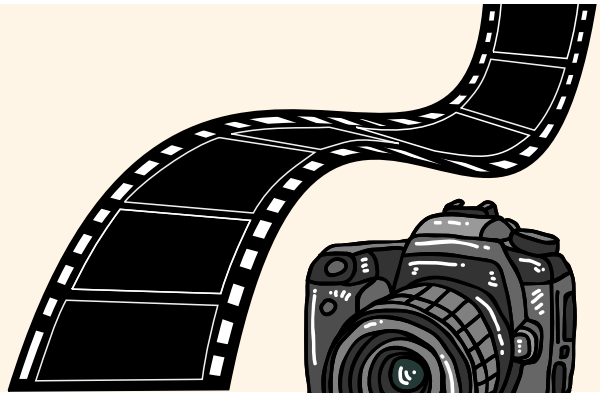
