Summary	SLSNSW is calling for nominations from athletes wishing to gain selection in one of five NSW teams to compete in the Super Surf Teams League (SSTL) for 2023-24

INTRODUCTION:

The Super Surf Teams League (SSTL) returns for the 2023-24 Season to provide states with high level competition across varying disciplines.

Super Surf Teams League 2024 will be held at Maroubra SLSC, across 3 rounds from Friday 12 – Sunday 14 January 2024.

SLSNSW will select five teams made up of discipline specific athletes. Each team will consist of 4 male and 4 female athletes to be eligible to compete in each round of SSTL.

Athletes will be selected based on regions. There will be no draft selection process. Teams will be as follows:

- Northern Dolphins
- Hunter/Central Coast Orcas
- Sydney Northern Beaches Rays
- Sydney Sharks
- Southern Penguins

Athletes will be selected based on the most geographically aligned Branch.

SLSNSW understands many athletes will be awaiting the Kelloggs Nutri Grain (KNG) Trials in mid-November. We encourage those athletes to nominate for the Super Surf Teams League and SLSNSW will adjust the SSTL teams based on qualification into the KNG series.

Note: Athletes competing in the NSW Interstate team will not be available for selection for SSTL.

SLSNSW is calling for nominations from athletes wishing to compete for NSW in the SSTL which will feature Swim, Board, Ski, Sprints and Flags as well as mixed team relays in each of the disciplines.

TEAM COMPOSITION:

- Each team will consist of a maximum of 4 male and 4 female competitors (a total of 8 competitors)
- All competitors must be proficient and eligible to compete in the Open category for the 2023-24 season (i.e., U17, U19 or Open).
- Competitors competing in the U15 age group for the 2023-24 Season are not permitted to compete.
- There are no restrictions or minimums on the number of U17, U19 or Open competitors per team.

COST:

Please be advised a levy of \$250.00 (inc. GST) per athlete will be invoiced to respective clubs. It will be up to the club to pass on this expense to the individual athlete.

Athletes will be provided with a team uniform comprising of, hoodie, hat, tee shirt, swimwear and competition cap.

COMPETITION EQUIPMENT & SPECIFICATIONS

- Each individual shall be responsible for the provision of their own equipment, including boards, skis, and paddles.
- All equipment used in competition is to comply with SLSA specifications.
- Random scrutineering of equipment may occur during the Series.

HOW TO NOMINATE

- All nominating members are asked to familiarise themselves with the <u>SLSNSW Selection Policy</u> and the SLSNSW Athlete & Management Agreement. All athletes will be required to comply with the guidelines and expectations set out in these documents.
- Complete the Online Nomination Form by 11pm Wednesday 15 November 2023.
- All nominees must be current financial members and proficient with their relevant awards.
- All nominations must be endorsed by Club prior to selection Any nomination that fails to meet this requirement will not be accepted.
- After the close of nominations, SLSNSW will provide a list of all nominations to Branches who will have 48 hours to endorse athletes – Non endorsed athletes will be advised by their Branch as to why.

SLSA CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

SLSNSW and SLSA expects that all members involved in SSTL will co-operate to ensure a positive public image and to participate in a spirit of goodwill and sportsmanship.

The SLSA Code of Conduct, Competing Unfairly and Abuse/Inappropriate clauses etc. are contained in the current edition of the Surf Sports Manual and any subsequent bulletins.

Any incidents or behaviour likely to cause embarrassment or damage to the reputation and/or image of lifesaving competition will be managed as prescribed in the current edition of SLSA's Rules, Surf Sports Manual and any subsequent bulletins.

SLSA ANTI-DOPING POLICY

Surf Life Saving Australia supports the Australian Government, SportAus, the AOC, and the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority (ASADA) in their efforts to eradicate the use of drugs in sport. SLSA has published an Anti-doping Policy, which will be adhered to for this event.

Please be aware that random drug testing by ASADA could take place during the SSTL. It is highly recommended each State/Territory team member (including management and staff) complete the ASADA online e-learning program (Level 1) to ensure all personnel are aware of contemporary issues pertaining to anti-doping.
