Subject:	2024 NSW Surf Life Saving Championships – Powercraft Requirements V2 – Note: Changes to shifts during OPEN and SURFBOAT Championships

This Memo outlines information regarding the volunteer Powercraft Roster for the 2024 NSW Surf Life Saving Championships

Powercraft

Clubs required to both provide IRB equipment and crews have been identified based on the average number of entries from this year's State Championship entries – **See Appendix.** (*which includes the roster and the clubs required to provide and IRB/engine.*)

Clubs are reminded that as per the SLSNSW Regulations only volunteer members are permitted to operate powercraft at the championships. Individuals must not be in receipt of payment for any powercraft services (excluding any individuals employed directly by SLSNSW or SLS Services). Members and clubs may be subject to disciplinary action if they are in breach of this provision in addition to being uninsured and not covered under any workers compensation normally made available to members as volunteers under the NSW Workers Compensation Act. Clubs may however undertake shifts for other clubs for a fee where the payment is made to the club and no payment is made to individual drivers and/or crew. Clubs undertaking such arrangements must advise SLSNSW of these arrangements.

Clubs who are unable to fulfill their IRB roster requirements can contact SLSNSW to secure SLS Services Australian Event Safety Services (AESS) to undertake those shifts. The fee per shift is \$550 (incl. GST) and must be advised by no later than Monday 19th February 2024. Please contact statechampionships@surflifesaving.com.au if you would like to pay for this service.

Where appropriate, Clubs are welcome to and are required to notify SLSNSW via statechampionships@surflifesaving.com.au if they have organized a shift swap with another roster Club.

If clubs do not provide required Powercraft Personnel according to the published roster, SLSNSW will stand down all athletes from that club from competition until such time as the required Powercraft Personnel are present.

A preliminary roster is attached, outlining the allocated shifts and timeslots in which Clubs are required to fulfill. Drivers and crew (Clubs) must provide their own PFD's, helmets (option for IRBs and mandatory RWCs) and suitable wetsuits/rash shirts to ensure comfort from both sun, wind, and cold conditions. The powercraft compound **will not** be in a position to provide this equipment.

Please be aware that **RWC volunteer shifts do not contribute to the Clubs contribution.**

Powercraft Drivers/Operators and crewpersons **must** fulfil the following requirements.

- ✓ **IRB Driver:** Be a current financial SLS member and be a proficient Silver Medallion IRB Driver.
- ✓ **IRB Crewperson:** Be a current financial SLS member, be a proficient IRB Crew Certificate.
- ✓ **RWC Operator:** Be a current financial SLS member and hold a proficient RWC Operator Certificate.
- ✓ **Both IRB and RWC:** Be experienced in ALL levels of surf conditions and competent to deal in all surf conditions.

Clubs will be required to nominate volunteer names and contact information for IRB Drivers and Crew personnel via [Microsoft Forms](#). This information will be audited via SurfGuard.

Summary

SLNSW acknowledges and thanks the hard work of members while at the State Championships. This event cannot be delivered safely and efficiently without contribution from Clubs.

All volunteer hours for Powercraft and Water Safety can contribute to an individual's total Club water safety hours. Members will be required to confirm their hours directly with clubs should they wish to have them included.

Should members become injured during their involvement in the Championships as either a competitor, official or water safety/powercraft personnel, Members are only able to make a claim through iCare (Work Cover) if the following applies:

1. The member is a current SLNSW financial member.
2. While undertaking a genuine, authorised activity as a surf lifesaver and the member was not receiving remuneration or reward. The member must be performing the activity voluntarily and without obligation.

1. Clubs will be required to bring an IRB, Motor and Fuel Cell. Please ensure all items are marked with the Club name.
2. IRB engines must be either Mercury or Tohatsu to ensure inter-operability across the IRB fleet during the championships.
3. It is requested all engines are a maximum of four (4) years of age and recently serviced to ensure driver and crew safety.
4. It is requested that all IRB's are fully inflated and functional ready for scrutineering at the time of drop-off.
5. The IRB compound is located in the Compound between Queenscliff and North Steyne SLSC, opposite Pacific St.
6. Please drop off your IRB at the Compound between 12pm – 4pm on Wednesday 6 March 2024.
