Subject:	Grant Opportunity – ASC Local Sporting Champions Program 2025-26 Rd 2 (Closing 31 October 2025)

<u>The Australian Sports Commission (ASC) Local Sporting Champions Program</u> is now open, <u>closing 31 October 2025</u>. The program is designed to provide financial assistance for coaches, officials and competitors aged 12-18 participating in state, national or international championships.

Funding of between **\$500 and \$750** for individual applicants is available, to contribute towards the cost of participation in the nominated championships:

- Base Grant: \$500
- Applicants travelling 800 km 1,999 km to their nominated championships: + \$100
- Applicants travelling internationally or greater than 2,000 km to their nominated championships: + \$200
- Applicants residing in a rural electorate: + \$50

## Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be turning 12 to 18 years of age in the same calendar year as the nominated sporting championships.
- Be an Australian citizen or have been granted permanent resident status, residing in Australia.
- Be participating as an athlete, coach, or match official in:
  - o an official state championships endorsed by the relevant ASC recognised national sporting organisation (NSO), National Sporting Organisations for people with Disability (NSOD) or a School Sport Australia member body; or
  - o an official national championship endorsed by the relevant ASC recognised NSO or School Sport Australia; or
  - o an international competition as a member of an official Australian team, representing an ASC recognised NSO or School Sport Australia.
- Those attending a state championship must be living more than 250km from the championships venue, and travelling greater than 500km return to participate in the nominated championships (Those attending a national championships or international competition do not need to be travelling a minimum distance to be eligible).
- Must incur out-of-pocket expenses equal to, or greater than, the grant amount they are eligible to receive.
- Must not receive a Local Para Champions grant or a Local Sporting Champions grant in the same or a previous round to attend the same championship or competition.
- Applications can be submitted at any time during the round opening and closing dates for competitions that occur
  within the relevant timeframes. For this round, eligible competitions are those held between 1 July 2025 and
  28 February 2026.
- Eligible expenses include competition/entry fees, transport and accommodation costs, equipment, uniforms, etc.
