### INFORMATION

SLSNSW is seeking nominations for Team Management roles to assist the five NSW teams in the 2025/26 Super Surf Teams League. The teams are Northern Dolphins, Hunter/Central Coast Orcas, Sydney Northern Beaches Rays, Sydney Sharks and Southern Penguins.

The SSTL will be held at Maroubra SLSC, across three rounds from 10 – 11 January 2026.

### THE ROLES AVAILABLE FOR EACH SSTL TEAM ARE:

- Head Coach (x1) – 1-year appointment
- Team Manager (x1) – 1-year appointment

### REQUIREMENTS OF TEAM MANAGEMENT

Desirable experience and attributes for the above Team Management roles include but not limited to:

- Head Coach to hold a current Development Coach Award.
- Financial SLSC member, endorsed by club & branch.
- Comprehensive knowledge of Surf Sports competitions and rules.

- Previous touring experience.
- Current First Aid certificate.
- Organise and attend all team training sessions.
- Demonstrated ability to think innovatively and strategically.
- Highly motivated and passionate about enhancing the success of NSW Athletes.
- Compile a report within three weeks of completing competition (Team Manager).
- Coach/Manager will be responsible for team configuration and coordinating athletes on the days of competition

### HOW TO NOMINATE

- Read the SLSA Super Surf Teams League Rules and Entry Circular (when available).
- All nominating members are asked to familiarise themselves with the SLSNSW [Selection Policy](#). All Team Management will be required to comply with the guidelines and expectations set out in this document.
- Complete the [nomination form](#) by 19 October 2025.
- All nominees must be current financial members and hold any relevant awards. All nominations must be endorsed by both Club and Branch representatives prior to selection, please contact your Club and Branch to acquire letters of endorsement – Any nomination that fails to meet these requirements will not be accepted.

The appointment period will commence from the date of appointment and will expire 28 days after the 2025/26 SLSA Super Surf Teams League.

### SLSA CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

- Members have responsibilities under Policy 5.2 Anti-Doping Policy and Policy 6.23 Illicit Drugs in Sport (both available online in the SLSA Members Portal).
