Nominations will close 11pm Sunday 7 December 2025.

Nominations should include details of the preferred roles you would like to fulfill, with two (2) preferences listed in order of priority. While every effort is made to appoint you to your preferred position, it is not always possible to do so.

OFFICIALS REQUIREMENTS

Surf Life Saving NSW is looking for accredited Officials who meet the following requirements:

- Be a current financial member of a club for 2025/26 season.
- Hold a minimum of a current Core Official accreditation for Age Championships.
- Hold a **minimum** of a current Technical Official accreditation for all other Championships.

The appointment of Officials will be made after the close of nominations and published on the <u>SLSNSW event webpage</u>.

OFFICIALS QUOTA

Please be aware that there is an Officials Quota System applied to Clubs for all NSW Championship events on the number of Officials required to be supplied. This quota is per event day.

For the Age Championships the quota will apply separately to both beach and water entry totals.

AGE CHAMPIONSHIPS

This quota will apply to both beach and water entries

Example: If you have 45 competitors in water and 15 competitors in the beach, you require 4 officials in the water area and 1 official in the beach area per day.

Please be aware the quota system is based on the number of competitors entered in the Championship, not the number of competitors starting. Clubs are reminded <u>before</u> entering their competitors into the entry system that they <u>MUST</u> meet the officials' quota.

Clubs **MUST** meet their required quotas, if required officials do not show for their appointed role, SLSNSW will stand down all athletes from that club from competition until such time as the required officials are present.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- In nominating for these events, all Officials warrant that they are, and must remain, mentally and physically capable of carrying out all the functions of their appointed role(s) over the course of the event. All Officials should undertake a medical check prior to the event. SLS NSW may request Officials to provide medical clearance if the Official has had a medical incident at a previous SLS event or if SLSNSW reasonably considers such a request is reasonable and/or necessary. If requested the Official must provide the medical clearance. SLS NSW reserves the right in its absolute discretion to:
 - a) not appoint an Official to any position whether an Official has nominated or not;
 - b) remove an Official from any position at any time (whether before or during an SLS NSW event)
- You must be able to get yourself to and from the beach without transport in a vehicle. Our safety guidelines currently do not include the transport of officials in the event of an emergency and therefore it is of the utmost importance that you demonstrate your capacity to fulfil your role with the parameters of our safety manual.
- SLSNSW is not obligated to give reason where it acts under this clause.
- All appointed Officials are encouraged to attend the Official's Briefings.
- Appointed Officials are responsible for all costs associated with travel and accommodation for the Championships.
- Officials are expected to wear a SLSNSW Country or State Championships Officials shirt.











- While every effort is made to appoint you to your preferred position, it is not always possible to do so. All appointments will be posted on the event page.
- All clubs will be required to provide a combination **both** water and beach officials to ensure the carnival can operate efficiently.
- Officials will be allocated to available positions. If the number of nominations exceed the
 positions available, those not selected will be placed into the 'Officials Pool' and positions
 may be allocated if they become available.
- Any late nominations will also be placed into the 'Officials Pool' and positions may be allocated if they become available.
- Appointed Officials will receive one (1) officiating shirt per championship officiated. I.e., One
 (1) for Age only, two for Age and Masters Championships. However, requested sizes are not guaranteed. If you have an official's shirt, we encourage you to bring it along.
- The quota system will be strictly enforced. It is the club's responsibility to provide adequate officials for the number of competitors entered.

LIVE HEATS

SLSNSW will continue using Live Heats at the 2026 Championships, and across NSW in the 2025/26 season, to enhance the on-beach experience for competitors, officials, and spectators. Some roles will require a level of understanding of the Live Heats system. Please keep this in mind when applying.
