#### Devices

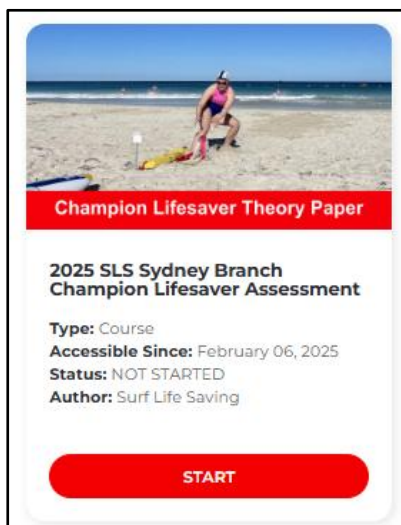
- Bring your own device (mobile phone, laptop, etc.), fully charged with its own internet access.
  - The venue will try to provide internet access but cannot guarantee so please make sure you can connect through your device.
  - Hot spotting from a second device is not allowed.
- Please make sure you know your login and password to the [SLS Hub](#).
- Please place devices on silent or 'do not disturb'.
- Please ensure you have Google Chrome downloaded on the device that you will use for the assessment.
- Smart watches and additional devices must be left in the your bag (the same as paper exam rules).
- It is advisable that your device is running on the latest operating software for your device e.g. Phone, Tablet or Laptop/MAC and you are on a release of Google Chrome starting with the number 143 at minimum.
  - If you have an older device you may be required to take the assessment on paper.
- Competitors will be provided with a blank piece of paper only if requested.

#### Access Instructions

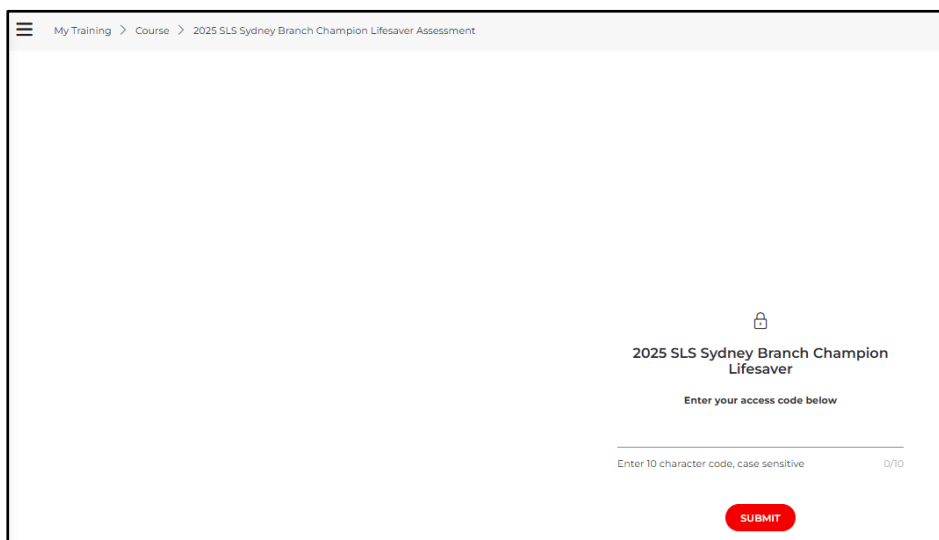
