We are now seeking nominations from all accredited Royal Life Saving or Surf Life Saving officials for the upcoming 2026 NSW Pool Lifesaving Championships.

While we will do our best to assign officials to their preferred roles, priority will be given to ensuring all key positions are appropriately filled for the smooth running of the event.

Please review the minimum official requirements per club, based on the number of competitors entered in the Championships:

1 to 4	0 Officials
5 to 15	1 Official
16 to 30	2 Officials
30+	3 Officials

If a club does not meet the required number of **accredited officials**, they may be contacted to help fill any remaining roles.

In addition to accredited officials, **each club must also provide volunteers** to assist with **timekeeping** and **equipment management** (pool setting) between events.

- **Rosters** for these volunteer roles will be shared shortly before the event.
- These volunteer roles **do not count** towards the club's official quota.

Please note: If volunteers fail to attend their rostered duties without prior notice, athletes from that club may be withdrawn from that session.

Your support in filling all required and rostered positions is greatly appreciated, as these roles are essential to keeping the event running on time.
